# **District 103 2025 Annual District Council Meeting Minutes**

**Date:** April 18, 2025

Location: Virtual (Zoom – Recorded to Cloud)

Call to Order: 9:00 AM

Presiding Officer: Sandra Lane, DTM, District Director

### 1. Call to Order & Welcome

• Meeting called to order at **9:00 AM** by District Director Sandra Lane, DTM.

- District Director Sandra Lane welcomed District leaders, Club Presidents, and Vice Presidents of Education, recognizing their leadership and sacrifice.
- Protocols were reviewed:
  - o Participants are to mute microphones unless they are recognized to speak.
  - Voting delegates are required to identify themselves when speaking.
  - o Chat could be used to seek recognition.
  - o Only those with voting rights may participate in discussions.

# 2. Inspirational Message

- **Presenter:** Cynthia Anglin, Area 51 Director.
- Cynthia Anglin delivered a moving reflection on leadership and resilience:
  - Posed the question: "If everyone in my district were just like me, what kind of district would my district be?"
  - Cited global trends showing more clubs closing than opening previously only seen during WWII and the COVID-19 pandemic.
  - Shared a metaphor of balancing a glass of water on a rollercoaster to illustrate the unpredictability of leadership.
  - o Encouraged perseverance, noting personal challenges but underscoring collective strength.
  - o Closed with the charge: "Be not weary in well-doing, for you will reap if you faint not. Leaders, don't faint—the district needs you."



### 3. District Mission Reminder

- The District Mission was read by District Director, Sandra Lane, DTM: "We build new clubs and support all clubs in achieving excellence."
- Lane emphasized that Distinguished District is not optional, but the standard expectation.

# 4. Credentials Committee Report

- **Presenter:** DTM Ivory Gwin.
- Verified **68 clubs in good standing**; quorum requirement was 23.
- Quorum achieved; report adopted without objection.

# 5. Adoption of Agenda

- Agenda had been distributed in advance; corrected version sent the night prior.
- Noted substitution: Valerie Smith presenting the Conference Committee report in place of Alisha Bannister.
- Agenda adopted without objection.
- NOTE: Parliamentarian, Elizabeth Stevenson, explained Parliamentary Rules & Procedures

# 6. Appointment of Finance Manager

- District Director, Sandra Lane, announced the resignation of **Finance Manager Damika Hayden** due to health concerns.
- Gregg Thompson, DTM, PDD was appointed as successor.
- Appointment approved without objection.



# 7. Audit Committee Report

- Presenter: Bruce Chambers, Audit Chair (with James Larmie).
- Audit Period: July 1 December 31, 2024.
- Findings: One missing pre-approval email for an expense >\$500. All other items compliant.
- Recommendations included:
  - o Provide clear receipts with each reimbursement.
  - o Label reimbursements to match specific budget categories.
  - Attach pre-approval to related documentation.
  - o Separate unrelated expenses into individual requests.
- Report adopted without objection.

# 8. Operational Guidelines Update

- **Presenter:** District Director Sandra Lane, supported by PDDs Dionne Leggin, Cassandra Lee, and Gregg Thompson.
- Updates clarified DEC and non-DEC roles, added deadlines, and district historical context.
- PDDs highlighted the guidelines as a cultural and leadership resource unique to District 103.
- Guidelines adopted without objection.
- Brief explanation of the process and procedures of the Operations Guidelines: Dionne Leggin, Cassandra Lee, DD, Sandra Lane.



# 9. Realignment Committee Report

- **Presenter:** Gary Behrens, Chair (with Kaushal Gupta, Derrick Kimbrough, Cheryl Lane, Don Williams).
- Goal: ensure ≥minimum of 4 active clubs in good standing per area and balance potential for growth.
- Recommendations:
  - 1. Metro Talk Club → Division B Area 11
  - 2. Alfred Benesch & Co. Club → Division F Area 81
  - 3. Prosperity Toastmasters → Division S Area 52
- Report adopted without objection.

# 10. District Conference Update

# 12. Club Growth Report

- **Presenter:** Latrina Oddo, DTM.
- Current standing:
  - o 15 clubs under 8 members.
  - o 68 paid clubs (goal: 83).
  - Need 8 Members to be active
  - o 2,603 membership payments (goal: 2,901).
  - o 7 Distinguished clubs (goal: 34).
  - o 67% of Area Director reports completed.
- Latrina Oddo urged members to support clubs at risk.
- Membership Building Campaign May 31<sup>st</sup> Blackstone Library.
